Stone benchtops adorn bespoke shaker-style timber cabinetry plus 6 burner gas/electric cooker, dishwasher and large pantry. To the rear of the home are two light and bright bedrooms each queen size, premier with walk-in robe and French doors to a private deck with steps leading to the rear garden. A water tank off the studio provides 20,000lts of garden water.
