The same level of meticulous care extends to the private rear gardens, where a master stonemason was commissioned to restore and revitalise the brick and sandstone elements. Step through the threshold into the sunroom, a tranquil spot for enjoying your morning cuppa while the sun peeks through the trees in King Edward Park. Adjoining the sunroom are lounge and dining rooms, each adorned with marble fireplaces; one now upgraded with a modern gas fire.
