Bottled gas is used for hot water and the cook-top, and they use three 45kg bottles a year. Outside you'll find the king of sheds, being 9x24m, with a 3.6m door height. The high pitch of the roof invites a mezzanine level to be installed, if you require further storage. The inclusion of a modern bathroom in the shed adds a level of convenience and luxury to those days you've got too many projects to think about going back to the house. The twenty-metre poly tunnel and raised beds will help kick-start your self-sufficient life, while the bespoke chicken coop and its resident ladies complete the package. With 67,400L of water storage and an easement and water drawing rights from the local creek, water supply should not be an issue. Two 40-foot containers add to the facilities of the property, with one being partially lined and a wood heater installed. Every day will be a pleasure to survey your property as you are treated to 360-degree views of local prominent mountains and the Fingal Valley. Steeped in history and recognised as a haven for people seeking an alternate lifestyle, St Marys is just fifteen minutes from spectacular East Coast beaches and forty minutes to the vibrant centre of St Helens.
