A light, open living area is the main space. This consists of an air-conditioned family room with a wood fire that also helps to heat the water, a dining area with a bay window and a lounge. To one side is the generous kitchen with a pantry, dishwasher, stainless steel chef's stove and an abundance of cabinetry as well as a breakfast bar. Enhancing the living options is a terrific, covered patio at the side, a sheltered area for barbies or relaxing with a cold beer after work. There's also a second outdoor seating area at the back with a fishpond. The semi-ensuite bathroom with a spa bath, walk-in shower, double vanity and toilet is accessed directly by the king-sized master bedroom adjoining - with built-in robes – and from the hall. The other two bedrooms are doubles. At the back door is a handy utility room incorporating the laundry and doors leading out to the impressive backyard. Of approximately 8m x 6m, the shed has a three-bay parking spot at the front, and there's ample space towards the rear boundary for bigger vehicles. For fresh eggs, the girls living the life of Riley in the hen house and chook run will oblige, and there's plenty of scope for growing fruit and veggies. A bore supplies water for the gardens, spa bath & at least one toilet, and a rainwater tank is connected to the house. This exceptional property, which promises an easy lifestyle of tranquillity among the native birds, animals and wildflowers, has been well maintained and is brilliantly presented throughout.
