A reverse cycle air conditioner and ceiling fans throughout the living area assist to keep the space at your ideal temperature. The kitchen is perfectly positioned for entertaining, even the kitchen sink has direct views of the ocean. The kitchen also features a fridge recess with overhead wine storage, large island bench with cupboards underneath, gas cooktop, electric oven and corner pantry. The king-sized room has a sliding door to the verandah and an aquatic themed porthole window. The white shutters have been configured so the sliding door still provides a seamless entry point to the front verandah. A large walk-in robe and an ensuite with double shower, vanity with built-in towel rails and toilet complete the suite. The ensuite is tiled to the ceiling. There is also a reverse cycle air conditioner. Two of the minor bedrooms are also located on the west side of the home. They both have double built-in robes, white shutters, roman blinds, and a large window to see the sea. The fourth bedroom is located across the hall and also has built-in storage. The main bathroom is finished in blue and crisp white and features a fully screened shower, bath and vanity. The laundry is nearby with cupboards under the bench and a separate toilet. There is plenty of storage with two walk in linen cupboard/storerooms. From the magnificent Tasmanian Oak flooring, through to the immaculate bathrooms, you can tell this house has been built and maintained to the highest standards. Outside, the wide verandahs and deck on the north west corner are finished with timber decking and marine wire balustrading. Underneath there is parking for two cars and a built-in powered storeroom.
