Take in sunrises, sunsets and vistas of Mt Beckworth from this special spot. Imagine the sound of the rain on the tin roof also equipped with 6.5 kilowatt solar panels. The front door opens to a welcoming foyer, ready for family photos and a hat stand. The floorplan is family friendly with four bedrooms, two bathrooms and two living areas. The front lounge, with an ambient wood heater, flows to the large kitchen/meals area through double sliding doors. The kitchen offers a walk-in pantry, excellent bench and cupboard space and an electric oven with a gas cooktop. Three robed bedrooms with ceiling fans are located in their own wing along with the tidy family bathroom, separate loo and laundry with external access. The private master suite features an ensuite and two BIRs. A gas wall heater, split system, vinyl plank flooring, exterior canvas blinds at the front and roll down shutters at the rear are practical features to note. The property is also connected to town water. Outside the secure house yard with tall fencing is a bonus for younger children and pets. A small orchard with plums, apples, pears and grapefruit features. Beyond there's a large back paddock with perimeter fencing.
