Jump clear of the rental "grind" and build your own, or maybe construct a couple of studios for long- or short-term rental income. This could be the place for your "forever home" where you can settle into a more self-sufficient lifestyle, collect rainwater, grow your own food, add in a few solar panels, and contribute to the rural life and community. Pearce Street, Branxholm is only 7 minutes' drive from the Derby MTB trail-head, with the beautiful 8km Valley Pond trail connecting the two towns. Many other natural gems of the North East await your exploration such as hiking trails, waterfalls, recreational lakes and rivers. Then there are attractions such as the Lilydale Lavender Farm and the Barnbougle Golf Course. Branxholm has its own pub, IGA Express, mechanic, swimming pool, pizza spots and a café. It is home to a thriving timber mill which sings happily in the background through the workday hours. A recent North Eastern Advertiser article highlighted an urgent need for experienced truck drivers in the area, and reliable workers are likely to be welcomed in any of the rural industries. Of course, there is always the work-from-home option with all of its possibilities. The town of Scottsdale is only 20 minutes away. It has a Woollies and an IGA, a hospital and aged care facility, a doctor's surgery, several mechanics and many other great local businesses. The North East is a friendly welcoming place, so if the ¼ acre dream beckons, why not check this one out?
