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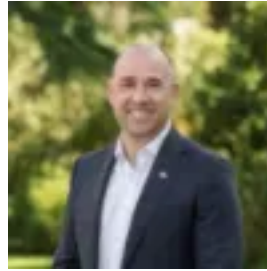

Enviably inner-city living meets an enchanting Victorian prospect with this c1880 terrace offering impressive space and contemporary style, just paces from some of Melbourne's most iconic leisure and dining precincts. Introduced by a traditional balconied terrace façade, the property commands attention, while the landscaped garden entrance offers an immediate sense of tranquillity. Positioned on a corner allotment, residents enjoy the privacy benefits of having just one adjoining neighbour, with the interior renovated and light-filled, seamlessly combining modern comfort with elegant design. A corbel-arch hallway, high ceilings with intricate cornicing, and modern oak flooring exude elegance throughout, with three bedrooms, including one on the ground floor, capturing views of the garden and substantial storage. On the upper level, two further bedrooms each boast built-in robes and leafy outlooks, with the main bedroom providing direct access to the balcony. An entertainer's domain opens to the rear of the home, where open-plan living and dining welcome year-round enjoyment through to a decked courtyard terrace, surrounded in seasonal colour from draped vines and striking Boston Ivy. A marble-bench kitchen is well-equipped with stainless steel appliances, whilst a powder room caters to easy living. Located mere footsteps to Clarendon Street's lively bars, cafes, dining options and trams, and only minutes to the CBD, Royal Botanic Gardens, entertainment and art precincts and Albert Park Lake on foot, this spectacular home includes a large central bathroom upstairs, a European laundry, ducted heating/cooling and extensive storage.
