Preceded by a picket fence and neatly maintained garden lined with Iceberg roses the home is attractively framed by a pair of Weeping Cherry trees; the façade features an iron lacework verandah introducing a previously renovated, extended and recently refurbished interior adding generous split-level contemporary living and entertaining areas to an original period layout.

Featuring high ceilings with roses and rose coloured glass, the polished timber central hallway is flanked by a formal sitting and dining room, three downstairs bedrooms with built-in robes, one with an ensuite and a family bathroom with spa bath. Through to an expansive family domain incorporating a superbly equipped kitchen with CaesarStone benchtops, large island bench, premium appliances including a Bosch double oven and Smeg stainless steel cooktop and adjacent laundry. Leading to an upstairs retreat and a large main bedroom with WIR, dual ensuite and balcony. Plus a covered alfresco entertaining area and an ornamental tree-lined, private garden with a central water feature - perfect for year round relaxation and dining. Other features include alarm, remote double garage with substaintial attic storage, access from Eyre Street. OFPs, ducted heating, R/C air conditioner (main bedroom), surround sound and Plantation shutters.

Complemented by a leafy tree-lined street moments from Whitehorse/Burke Road transport options, Deepdene Primary and Village shops, cafes, restaurants and the Balwyn Cinema; plus easy access to some of Melbourne's finest schools, including Kew High zoning, plus several nearby parks or the Outer Circle trails for recreation.
