Beyond the private front fence the drive-way leads to the large double garage (6m x 6m) and the bull-nose verandah leading to the front door. Upon entry you instantly have a sense of space and natural light and can't help but be drawn into this inviting home. The large front living area is an inviting space which wraps around to the dining area with access & views out to a private undercover courtyard. The renovated kitchen will impress with its functionality and quality features including stainless gas cook-top & wall oven, dishwasher, abundant bench space, soft-close doors and pantry with slide-out drawers. Along the central hallway there is also a functional laundry with external access, huge linen storage and a stunningly renovated central bathroom and separate toilet.
