

Downstairs is the formal lounge area, rumpus with conservatory windows and sliding door, open laundry, separate toilet and internal access to the garage. A mezzanine in the garage provides plenty of storage space, in addition to the many storage options throughout the home. The 2.5 acres approx. (1.02 ha) of land consists of flat grassed areas, an enclosed entertaining area, and the back portion slopes down to the natural bushland. There is plenty of scope to build a shed or other outbuildings if desired.
