The kitchen, living, and dining areas are semi-open plan; this clever design has offered each space an intimate feel, without sacrificing the light or the views entering each area. The kitchen is absolutely delightful and ideal for those who love to cook and entertain. There is a large, central workspace with a solid timber benchtop, that doubles as a breakfast bar, and there is plenty of storage, as well as stone benches, and quality appliances. The master bedroom is very spacious and provides a recently renovated ensuite, a walk in wardrobe, and additional closet space. Views of the river can be enjoyed from here, as well as the charming outlook over the gardens. Two additional bedrooms, each offering built-in robes are found near the family bathroom, which is a bespoke space that is home to the claw foot tub and walk-in shower. A fourth bedroom or home office sits at the other end of the house and offers its own private access.A large laundry and utility room fills the space between the kitchen and office area and provides built-in storage and worlds of potential. It's perfect to use as an overflow pantry or can be used in conjunction with the study area, creating a small second living option. The double garage, with automatic doors, provides covered entry via this space and is large enough to incorporate a workshop. Outside is just as impressive as the home itself - thoughtfully positioned plantings have created a park-like feel and there are many spots in which to entertain and admire the views of the Huon. A lovely dam sits at the bottom of the garden and can be used to help water if needed, it's currently a favoured spot for the visiting wildlife and native frogs. In addition to the cleared pastures and more structured gardening around the house, particular attention has been given to the native grasses and eucalypt stands. Traditional land care practices have been part of the ongoing care here, which sees the property thriving.
