Ensuring comfort and efficiency, this two bedroom home is equipped with full wool insulation, externally set double-glazed windows, underground power supply, and a 55 thousand litre primary water tank (plus 1000 litre vegetable garden tank). Also installed is lightning-fast Starlink satellite broadband internet. Additional storage is provided by a 40-ft container (with power available) included with the sale.

In addition, a stand-alone cottage with solar power (off grid) is located on the property and is ideal for working from home, a third bedroom or teenage retreat or artist studio offering sweeping views of the valley below.

Located in the quaint village of Binda (an easy 2:45 hr drive from Sydney or 1:15 hrs from Canberra), local amenities such as a general store, primary school, and Australia Post outlet enrich the community, while comprehensive town facilities are a short 15-minute drive away in Crookwell.
