

Nestled on manageable 7.6 hectares (18+ acres), just 20 minutes south of Oatlands, this property offers a well-presented family home with lock-up storage sheds; all-weather turning circle with a low-maintenance established garden surrounding the home. The freshly painted three-bedroom brick veneer home is well layout for the growing family. Constructed in 1950, the home offers good-size bedrooms, living/dining which is heated by a reverse cycle air conditioning unit and free-standing woodfire and practical country kitchen with plenty of cupboard storage. Two-way toilet, storage room and bathroom with seperate shower and bath tub are all well-maintained for the age of the home. Undercover patio (accessed from the backdoor) offer an additional living space during the warm months. An orchard and vegetable patch are awaiting for planting of winter vegetables to be in keeping with the self-sustainable on offer at this property. The home is connected to two above ground poly tanks and a septic system. The 7.6 ha is divided into four well-fenced paddocks with a small dam offering stock water supply and the property is currently being grazed with cross-bred ewes. Settled in 1866, Tunnack was named after the aboriginal dialect 'cold' and has had strong agricultural tries as growing wheat, potatoes, and sheep on the nearby farming properties. Nowadays, Tunnack is a supportive, close-knit community of families living and working within the Tasmanian Midlands. The local community patronises the Tunnack Community Club for catchups with friends/or organised events every week. A bus school service commutes to Oatlands and Campania and Australia post delivers to a PO Box outlet in the village centre. Tunnack is only 45 minutes to the Tasmanian east coast township of Orford and a little 1 hours drive to Hobart CBD.
