The nursery can also produce Black Genoa Figs, Kwai Mai Pink Lychees, Acerola Cherries, and many other fruit varieties The water supply, and reticulation is fully automated. The 3 phase, multi stage centrifugal pump extracts from the 150 megalitre, deep water storage to the Turkeys Nest atop the hill and syphons back, under pressure, to the nursery and trees. The B & BWith the original homestead tucked neatly between the Rainforest and the Orchard, what better opportunity than to operate the unused rooms in the very much sought after licensed B & B. The upstairs rooms consist of 2, 2 bedroom family units, with 9 beds available, with individual bathrooms. There are 2 common areas and a fully licensed Commercial kitchen.
