A peaceful sanctuary with sunlit NE aspect, this classic apartment enjoys harbour views from its rear setting on Level 2 of 'Four Macleay', a gracious Art Deco building on fashionable Macleay Street. Sweeping across the harbour to Clark Island, Shark Island and The Heads, the views are captured from wall-to-wall windows in the living/dining area and bedroom, while the kitchen has a tranquil leafy outlook. As well as NE harbour views, the bedroom has an Elizabeth Bay cameo vista reminiscent of a Brett Whitely painting with palm trees in the foreground and yacht-filled bay beyond. High ceilings and timber floors complement the immaculate interiors with wide entry hall, modern kitchen and Deco bathroom. In a well-managed security building with timber-panelled foyer and new double-glazed windows throughout, the apartment offers an enviable village lifestyle with 250m to Woolworths Metro and footsteps to Challis Avenue's café/dining scene.
