Sitting pretty along Brisbane River, Corinda in Brisbane's southwest is a quiet and leafy suburban neighbourhood that strikes a chord with family-friendly living. From prestigious schools to beautifully restored Queenslanders to well-connected transport links – and all with plenty of parklands to go around. Oxley Road is the commercial hub of Corinda, with a selection of grocery stores, small businesses and restaurants that shine a spotlight on global eats. Adding to Corinda's village-like feel is the local schools, library, cafes, and Corinda Railway Station, which has locals into Brisbane City within 20-minutes, and Indooroopilly Shopping Centre in even less time. There are also golfing facilities in the southern areas of Corinda, a boating club along Brisbane River and a horse and pony club tucked away near Cliveden Avenue Reserve. And in neighbouring Sherwood, there is the impressive heritage-listed Arboretum.
