Infrastructure on the site is extensive and includes 7 x shade houses, insulated 8x5m office/shed (built in 2019), packing shed with 10kW solar power, bore, 2 x 25,000-litre rainwater tanks, compost toilet, and various sheds to store equipment and machinery. Not only specialising in over 250 varieties of aquatic plants including lotus and water lilies; they also specialise in over 10 different species of ginger, over 50 varieties of heliconias, and stock a range of indoor plants. There is also a range of fruit trees onsite including mandarin, orange, lemon, lemonade, lime, jaboticaba, bananas, mango, passionfruit and more, plus vegetable gardens.Located approximately halfway between the historic hinterland railway towns of Beerwah and Landsborough with the iconic Glass House Mountains a stunning backdrop on the landscape; 30 minutes to coast beaches, and with quick easy access to the M1 connecting you to Brisbane in 60 minutes - you can live the acreage dream, work for yourself in a viable business with potential for growth and diversification, without sacrificing access to major amenities.
