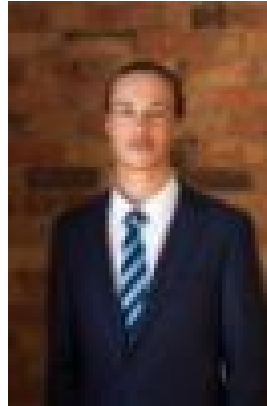

Originally built as a school in 1889, it was first known as the Ulverstone Preparatory School, then Ulverstone Grammar and Agricultural School. It continued as a school for 12 years. In 1901 the school was closed as the state school system was expanded to Ulverstone. It then became a home and renamed Wangford, after Wangford on the east coast of England. The substantial home now boasts five bedrooms, two bathrooms, three living rooms, a dining room and a study. There's also a larger double garage and an attached studio or workshop plus a carport high enough to accommodate a boat, caravan, camper van. Gardens are well established and have a variety of fruit and native plants. All this is set on a generously sized block of 1801m² (close to half an acre) in one of our most sought-after streets.
