Standing tall at the start of Binnak Drive, this double storey, executive residence presents as a generously proportioned family home and the ideal entertainer with a superb chef's kitchen at its heart. A magnificent stone island bench/breakfast bar with pendant lighting holds centre stage and features dual Electrolux Pyroluxe ovens, Smeg 5 burner cooktop, Asko dishwasher, dual stainless sinks and loads of storage while the adjacent dining area opens onto a large elevated and covered deck with heaters. A well-proportioned family room/home theatre with projector and screen is ideally positioned just behind the kitchen and also opens onto the deck while the long rectangular living room to the left of the entrance foyer links with the dining space creating a harmonious connection between indoor and alfresco entertaining areas. Taking the carpeted stairs to the upper level reveals a lounge/study area and four of the five bedrooms, all of which are of ample dimensions, including the bright master which offers a walk-through robe and beautiful, fully tiled ensuite bathroom. The family bathroom is also on this level and features the luxury of a freestanding, deep soak bath and frameless shower. Features include ducted heating and evaporative cooling, powder room, quality drapes and carpet, polished Blackbutt timber flooring, under-stair cupboard, laundry with storage cupboards, external storeroom, garden shed and double auto garage with rear roller door. Ideally positioned just metres from 566 bus (RMIT, Latrobe University, Northland, Greensborough Plaza and Watsonia and Greensborough stations) this solid family home is also in close proximity to Watsonia North Primary School, Parade College, Loyola College & Greensborough Secondary College and also allows easy access to the Metropolitan Ring Road.
