Calacatta Marble benches and stainless-steel appliances form a timeless combination in a light-filled contemporary kitchen that opens to a north-facing courtyard, as well as a dining room and a lounge - ambiently warmed by a gas log fireplace - all of which is rich in original character and enhanced by engineered French Oak flooring. Upstairs, a pair of bedrooms have been finished with built-in robe storage and set adjacent to both a fully tiled bathroom and a study. Meanwhile, downstairs, the third bedroom is huge and independently accessed with a kitchenette and its own ensuite offering potential to be used alternatively as independent accommodation, a large home office or additional living area with seamless connection to a large alfresco entertaining area. The possibilities are endless. Additional highlights of this thoughtfully conceived home include driveway parking, a powder room, a mini bar area with wine fridge and under stair storage, as well as a large, lined attic, plus there are robust security systems, split system heating and air conditioning. This is a terrific inner urban position merely metres from St James Park and city-bound Yarra trails, within comfortable walking distance of the locally iconic Barton Street Milk Bar, great cafes, bars, eateries and local shopping on Burwood Road, plus you have city-bound trams and trains from Hawthorn Railway Station.
