A fine addition to the streetscape, this gable-fronted terrace offers a world of opportunity in a community minded neighbourhood away from the hustle and bustle but just 450m to South King Street's dining and social scene. Available for the first time in 26 years, the single-storey home is set on a deep dual access block with a north-east facing courtyard at the rear and convenient rear access via Pearl Lane. Comfortable as is with a fluid layout and 3m high ceilings, there's so much potential here with a large attic offering potential for a future second storey addition as well as scope for parking (STCA).
