Excellent water security - all paddocks setup with troughs connected by underground pipe and fed by on farm bore producing high quality water • Additional 11 dams/soaks and a winter active creek • 18 main paddocks, 6 smaller ram paddocks, 3 quarantine (containment paddocks) plus laneways with gravel roadways connecting all paddocks for rotational grazing purposes. Nearly all main paddocks have scratching posts and some tree shelters. All fencing installed in late 2018 with double steel gates and hotwire around the farm boundary. Kikuyu based pastures with ryegrass and clover species • Property currently run as a sheep enterprise would also be suited to cattle and areas of the farm to cropping • Soil and plant nutrition on the farm has been backed by expert agronomic advice ● Initial lime applications beginning in 2018 with 10-38t/ha of high quality limesand (Lancelin and Boranup) being applied and then most paddocks receiving subsequent applications resulting in pH levels now sitting around pH 6 • Initial fert applications of approx 900kg/ha total of either Super CZM or Agras CZM and subsequent annual applications (spread 4-6times/yr) of >60kg/ha P, >70kg/ha K, >40kg/ha S as well as cobalt, selenium, zinc and copper at above average rates. Significant manganese was also applied in 2023 • Caluka Farms focus has been to produce sheep that needed no human intervention. They now use Ultrawhite and Kojak rams and have focused on worm resistance, shedding, fat and muscle deposition and retention (resilience) and less feet problems.
