Four dams on the property provide enough water for a few head of cattle or horses. One of the dams is spring-fed and has never been dry. There are some very good areas of black soil on the property. And with plenty of native wildlife, one can often enjoy the sight of, the mountain parrots and koalas in the trees. Treed shade camps provide shelter for the stock over the winter and summer months. The country in the Anduramba area is tightly held and very rarely provides an opportunity to purchase a rural block so close to Crows Nest.
