Each of the three bedrooms have carpets and built-in wardrobes. The upstairs bathroom has dual access from bedroom two or the hallway and features a corner shower, built-in bath and separate toilet. Additional features include roof solar panels for energy efficiency, security screens on each window and a ceiling fan in bedroom two upstairs. Outside, sprawling grapevines and an abundance of mature fruit trees live amongst the gardens surrounding this home; pear, apricot, apple, lime, guava, orange, lemon, grapefruit and loquat. Keen gardeners will appreciate tending to their very own established, edible garden with something on offer each season. There's also a sunny courtyard spot in the corner, perfect for a cafe style table and chairs, with a large outdoor pizza oven nearby. A paved brick path winds around the home, hugging the exterior.
