In addition to the flexibility of living provided the the two masters, there are three additional bedrooms, where one is an ideal size for a home office, with additional work from home functionality in the upstairs mezzanine living space. With lovely natural northern light spilling in from all angles, this cleverly conceived design offers multiple living spaces, an open fireplace, dining room and casual family/meals area. You'll be comfortable all year round with recently installed ducted evaporative heating and cooling. The kitchen is equipped with black Caesarstone benchtops, breakfast bar, brand new dishwasher and oven and plenty of sparkling white soft-touch cabinetry. Outdoor entertaining area catered to by two pergola-covered dining space, with built in fridge and BBQ and fairy lights, a vegetable garden and apple tree, and low maintenance planting to ensure you can maximise your home time. There is also plenty of storage with two sheds. Lord Reserve is on your doorstep, the choice of tram and two train lines with Glen Huntly and Carnegie stations close by, and a splash away from soon to be redeveloped Carnegie Swim Centre.
