Showcasing beautifully manicured gardens and timeless period detail, a compelling façade reveals a sumptuous interior, with soaring, detailed ceilings enriching a broad entrance hall and four expansive, original rooms. Complemented by an abundance of storage throughout, built-in robes join a stylish central bathroom in serving three generous lower bedrooms, while a dressing room and dual-basin ensuite enhance a luxe upstairs master. Affording smart separation for large and growing families, a substantial lower lounge sees a gas-converted fireplace make for warm and cosy winter nights, while a sizeable upper office and downstairs study station underline the home's function-focus.
