Stretching from the French doors that open to the front verandah, through the heart of the home and spilling out to the rear entertaining deck, creating a superb balance between indoor and outdoor living. The well-equipped, modern kitchen is ideal for any chef with an abundance of bench space to whip up culinary creations, including a breakfast bar for after school snacks. Ample storage space keeps clutter tucked away maintaining the crisp finish whilst a feature northerly window provides natural light. Accommodation is provided by four bedrooms, with an oversized main bedroom offering an ensuite and large built-in robes. Three generous bedrooms for kids or guests have direct access to the main bathroom and two of the three are equipped with built-in robes.
