Hidden behind the façade of one of Bendigo's rare Art Deco heritage icons is this New York-style loft apartment, bathed in light and oh-so easy to love. Enjoy the city's grand and gracious CBD as your very own backyard, where leafy Rosalind Park, artsy View Street, award-winning cafes and restaurants and boutique shopping are just beyond the private entrance. The property is a feat of architectural brilliance, incorporating timeless interior features such as a double-height raked ceiling, skylight and clerestory windows, exposed beams, polished floorboards and white painted masonry walls. The flexible floorplan is full of intrigue and possibility, thanks to the spacious, full-length loft area. There are two larger-than average bedrooms off the long entrance hall, both with a built-in-robe and brick feature wall. The beautiful bathroom has a shower over a corner spa bath, a floating vanity and blue-sky views. The open-plan living area and kitchen will be the go-to place for all future gatherings. The current owners' indoor plants are thriving in the natural light, just as you will.
