Stepping inside, the home's beauty is reflected in the hall's high ceilings, off which leads the lounge and formal dining, both with ornate fireplaces, the contemporary kitchen, complete with bespoke cabinetry, butcher block counters, farmhouse sink, tiled splashback, and premium, stainless-steel cooktop oven and dishwasher, and east-facing, landscaped courtyard, comprising a perfectly private home office with a vista over the mature garden, and ROW access via Little George Street.Ascending the restored, original staircase to the upper level finds the home's three bedrooms, including the spacious primary with built-in robes and fireplace, all serviced by two bathrooms, the larger sublime one boasting terrazzo-look floors, walk-in shower, free-standing designer tub, floating vanity and skylight.
