The 6.16m x 6.06m lock-up boat shed will impress, leave your boat securely stored with all the equipment necessary for life on the water! The shed has double sliding doors with concrete floor and power connected, together with a housing covering the newly installed pressure pump, which is used to irrigate the grounds. The boat ramp and jetty complete the properties improvements. In summer when the river really comes to life you will marvel at the activity, yachts in full sale, boats with skiers in tow and the magnificent wooden boats as they cruise the river. From the moment you arrive at this stunning spot, you can't help but relax. It's only a five-minute drive into the Goolwa township and you are within easy reach of the Murray Mouth and entry to "The Coorong". The South Coast beaches beckon and the restaurant and café selection from Islanders Tavern at the Hindmarsh Marina to those found in Goolwa, will only add to the experience!
