

Used for recreational fishing for brook trout, brown trout and rainbow trout, Lake Leake offers a peaceful bush setting but is still commutable to Campbell Town or Swansea on the Tasmanian East Coast. Only 35 minutes east of Campbell Town and 45 minutes to the 'Great Eastern Drive' of Tasmanian East Coast, 6 Brewis Place is an affordable parcel of land awaiting future development by any trout fishing enthusiasts or buyers seeking peaceful bush surrounds of the Eastern Tiers of Tasmania.
