LOCATION - This fantastic property is situated in a pristine pocket of the Blue Mountains. Springwood High is located nearby, and the Norman Lindsay Gallery is one of your closest neighbours. Surrounded by lush bushland - you will enjoy the opportunity to explore scenic bush walks, and listen to the call of the native birds in the nearby tree canopies. Faulconbridge station is 5 minutes by car and access to the Great Western Highway is only 4 minutes away. Springwood CBD is less than 10 minutes by car, offering shops, cafes, pubs, clubs and more.

STYLE - This stunning retreat is the quintessential cabin in the mountains, surrounded by approximately 2.6 acres of bushland. There is a combustion fireplace in the lounge room, adding to the ambience of this light-filled mountains home. With rustic exposed wood ceilings and wooden paneled feature walls - this property is warm and inviting. The kitchen and bathrooms have been stylishly renovated. The kitchen features wooden benchtops, stainless steel appliances and plenty of storage space. The bathroom is the perfect hybrid of rustic meets modern style with chic white tiles on the walls, and heated grey floor tiles, a semi-freestanding tub and combined shower and hanging wooden vanity.

LAYOUT - This fantastic family home offers five large bedrooms, three on the ground floor and an additional two on the first floor. The master bedroom offers a walk in robe, ensuite and a deck off the back of the property where you can enjoy the sweeping views. There are two more bedrooms, one with a built-in robe on this level, and a spacious lounge room opening onto the sprawling back verandah. The dining and kitchen flow from the living area and enjoy the same gorgeous views of the greenery outside. On the first floor there are two larger bedrooms including ceiling fans and built-in robes as well as a large family room with reverse cycle air conditioning, study nook & main bathroom to service this area. There is a balcony off the family room enjoying elevated views.

FEATURES - The location of this home is unbeatable. Surrounding by simply stunning bush views and with over 2.6 acres of land to enjoy, this home is shrouded in tranquillity and privacy. The home is the epitome of a cosy cabin in the woods, but with more than enough space to raise the growing family. There are wooden floors on the ground floor, with carpet in the bedrooms, and lots of exposed timber walls and wooden support beams, adding to this property's rustic charm. The kitchen renovation includes black stained cupboards and pantry and wooden bench tops with a breakfast bar. There are picture windows all around the kitchen giving the space a light and airy feel. There are three decks off the rear of the property, all with an elevated position enabling you to sit back with a cuppa and enjoy the surrounding mountains views. Beneath the main verandah there are two huge water tanks. There is a detached studio space perfect for working from home needs as well as a carport to park 2 cars. If you are searching for a tree change in a peaceful environment, this property is an absolute must see.
