Open home scheduled for 11am 30th September - cancelledPurchased by James Dalton in 1855 from the Crown for four pounds, the building could probably be described as "late Federation" consisting of 25 rooms with an imposing street façade. Edward Dalton's family lived in the home for about five years until they sold the property to the Catholic Church in 1924 for six thousand pounds. In March 1980, Ernest and Gwenda Shave bought the property and moved in with their three children. The floor of the hall still has the original tiles and is in almost perfect condition. The exposed timber on the interior is Queensland maple, including the staircase. The staircase and stairwell are the most impressive of their type in any private home in Orange.
