The wrap around front deck with pergola has a northerly aspect, perfect for a morning coffee. Elegant plantation shutters along the front of the home add to the impression. The welcoming entry reveals the chic interior refreshed in a fresh neutral shade, with an unmistakable Hampton theme, and opens into the intimate lounge, furnished with plantation shutters. Exposed brickwork of the fireplace is an authentic feature, which could be opened up again or used for an electric fireplace. Picture rails extend through the open plan lounge and dining, which offer views over the deck and garden to Black Mountain tower. Stacker doors from the dining area allow seamless flow through onto the magnificent entertaining deck with its remarkable pitched roof pergola, the structural timber a decorative feature. The attention is immediately drawn to an amazing spa pool, its sparkling warm water offering blissful relaxation all year round! The dining area flows into the stunning, new galley kitchen, highlighting the beauty of Merbau timber in the generous expanse of benchtop with waterfall edges, and overlooking the deck through a garden window. Appliances include an induction cooktop, glass rangehood, stainless steel oven and dishwasher, while a laundry nook at the end includes a large pantry. Attractive ash toned flooring and LED downlighting feature throughout the home. Ducted gas heating and evaporative cooling ensure comfort, and a 10.6 kW solar system minimises costs. Bedrooms are spacious, light and airy, and the master offers a wall of built-in robes, shelving and new ensuite. The new main bathroom features identical quality finishes, and both have in-slab heating. At the rear of the home, a generous, fully insulated rumpus harmonises with the exterior of the home and can also be used as a home office or teen retreat. There is a firepit and play space in the rear garden with inground watering to front and back gardens. The tree lined streets reflect decades of history and are a delight to explore. North Ainslie primary and Dickson College are only a short walk, while many other well regarded schools are close by.
