Quality soft and sweet mixed scrub soils being originally timbered by Brigalow, Belah, Wilga, Box, Sandalwood, Ironbark with scattered bottle trees throughout.Locked in PMAV vegetation mapping shows the property is completely category X and can be utilised for farming or grazing operations."Newholme" is watered by 2 sub artesian water bores both equipped with electrical down hole submersible pumps. These bores service 2 troughs located in 1 holding paddock & the yards, They also supply water to 3 x 30,000 litre water storage tanks and the cottage. This is backed up by 3 supporting dams with the largest being approx. 8,000 yards in size. Separated into 4 main paddocks, 2 smaller holding paddocks and a lane way. The internal & boundary Fencing is all new 5 barbed construction, with drill pipe and cattle rail end assemblies apart from the northern boundary & the eastern internal fence which is in older condition but is regarded as stock proof. Improvements on the property consist of a 2-bedroom cottage with kitchen, shower and toilet along with a front veranda. A Large 16 bay machinery shed measuring in at 4.2m high, 18m wide & 18m long. A shearing/storage shed is also located on the property 16m Wide x 18m Long. Steel framed cattle yards constructed in 2019 with a working capacity of up to 150 adult head is equipped with a loading ramp, drafting pound, undercover vet crush & branding cradle setup and ready for operation. Carrying capacity is estimated to run 180 grower steers at 1 head per 6 acres. Services to the property include bitumen access to the front gate, rural power, school bus run, mail service twice weekly, primary & secondary education at Bymount state school P-6, Roma State College P-12 or St John's catholic school P-12, Roma hospital located approx. 70 kilometers away.
