The grounds here span over five acres and have been filled with over 60 varieties of fruiting trees, apricots, peaches, pears, and figs, just to name a few. There are two dams, as well as dedicated tanks to irrigate the gardens and there are open paddocks, a chicken coop, and masses of bird attracting native plantings.
