The home has been renovated in recent years and is a fabulous blend of art deco with modern lifestyle. The galley kitchen has granite benctops as far as the eye can see while the two large bathrooms are equally matched with quality and presentation. Solid timber floors feature throughout along with double glazed windows, neutral tones and spacious living areas. The family living room invites you in to it's warmth with a large open fire and reverse cycle air conditioning - but it is the double sliding doors that lead straight to the deck and out to the ocean that steal your heart. Without question, this is a statement room that cannot possibly be appreciated simply from a photograph, this is a home that you must see in person. You must stand in the sun and hear the waves crash in front of you. You must feel the warmth on your cheeks as you look up and down the coastline. You can't feel that in a photograph, and when you do feel it, you'll understand why this home is so incredibly special. Space, abundance and embracing the outdoors are evident in every corner of this home.
