The home now features a sizeable laundry, three new bathrooms, New Zealand wool carpets and a Carrara marble kitchen fitted with V-Zug and Liebherr appliances. The self-contained studio is an ideal creative workspace or fourth independent bedroom with its own en-suite. Designed for year-round outdoor entertaining there is a central flag stoned slate courtyard, level lower lawned garden and grand balcony that opens into an uninterrupted view of Harry Seidler reserve.

Asymmetrical wood-lined ceilings soar in both the foyer and upstairs living areas, creating a sense of even greater light and original style. Sustainable and temperate, this is a house of rare privacy where every part of the floorplan is alive with inspired function and flexibility. Nestled in a cul-de-sac with a private park and enveloped by bird life in an easy-care garden of Camelias, Iris and Jacaranda, this is a home for all seasons that will translate across generations.
