Protected by the state's only Environmental Living zone and named after a group of small islands in a bend in the Yarra, The Bend Of Islands or 'The Bend' as the locals call it, delivers a uniquely tranquil, nature-focused existence just 30 k's from the CBD and within easy reach of Warrandyte, Eltham, Hurstbridge and Diamond Creek and the Yarra Valley. Taking full advantage of the contours of the land yet blending seamlessly with the surroundings, cedar boards wrap around a surprisingly spacious interior that takes full advantage of breathtaking views that you will relish every hour you are home!Look down, and you can see the Yarra flowing past. Look across the treetops, and you'll take in a stunning view all the way to the Dandenong's and the Mt Lofty State Park, never to be built out. Look up, and you'll catch the visiting birdlife enjoying the sanctuary of no introduced predators. Finished with picture windows, the ground floor introduces an open plan living-meals. Enhanced by soaring ceilings over timber floors and integrating an Ilve 900 mm range, it opens to an elevated deck where you can relax and toast your good fortune while admitting the ever-changing outlook. The main bedroom on this level also enjoys access to its own deck and is complemented by a loft bedroom.
