A 10 minute drive to the heart of Hobart, with a bus stop just outside the house and easy bike access to the Rivulet track, commuting to the city and school drop-off is a breeze. Set over 812 sqm, this property has sensational all-day sun with views to the river and to beautiful kunanyi/ Mt Wellington.
