Well fenced into 5 paddocks, including 2.8 kilometres of new internal and boundary fencing, "Esme Vale" boasts an LLS stocking rate of 700 DSE, and is currently running 600 merino wethers on only half the property. 50 head capacity timber/steel cattle yards and 1050 head capacity new steel "StockPro" sheep yards, allow for easy livestock management.
