Upper level accommodation comprises three well-proportioned bedrooms, two of which are appointed with built-in wardrobes and the master adjoins an enclosed sunny balcony. Additional features include a sleek fully tiled bathroom plus a concealed internal laundry on the lower level, an additional w/c, multiple ceiling fans and gas bayonets.
