A 2.4kw Voltech off-grid system keeps the house alive with no connection to mains power whatsoever. A Nature Loo composting toilet system and a 90,000 concrete water tank take care of all the other essential services. With several fruit and vegetable gardens around the property, you'll feel like a world away from it all while having the convenience of local amenities and being 10 minutes to the Bruce Highway.
