Stepping inside, the meticulously designed floorplan connects you from the light-filled foyer to the open-plan kitchen, dining and living zone. Soaring ceilings, 19mm Tasmanian oak flooring and a Sculpt fireplace are on show with the kitchen boasting polished concrete floors, a walk-in pantry, an island and a suite of premium appliances including a 900mm gas cooktop. A wrap-around 140mm spotted gum verandah provides the perfect place to entertain or simply relax in the shade and admire this serene setting. All four bedrooms are set in their own wing with generous master suite offering a built-in robe, a walk-in robe, an ensuite and direct access to the deck. This slice of paradise is perfectly positioned only five minutes (approx.) from Cygnet and you're less than an hour from the centre of Hobart.
