A rare offering in a highly sought after district, this hilltop sanctuary is around 10 minutes to Kyneton, 6 minutes from Malmsbury and only 90km (60 minutes) from Melbourne Airport. The surrounding area has an exemplary reputation as a cool climate grape growing area, and for permaculture. The sunny north, east and west facing slopes present a viable viticulture option, as the region is well known for producing cool climate wines, having been reintroduced by Tom Lazar, formerly 'Virgin Hills vineyard', on Salisbury Road in 1968. Access from both Honeysuckle Road and Salisbury Road Reliable dam Nearby rural properties have bores that tap into aquifers and a Land Capability Assessment reveals potable groundwater at approx. 10m below the surface. The property would support a sustainable agricultural enterprise such as a vineyard, olive grove or stone fruit orchard. The property would be suitable for equine activities, which Macedon Ranges Shire Council see as a favourable form of land use. Note, the property is zoned Farming (FZ) and there is no 'As Of Right' ability to build a dwelling on the property under the Macedon Ranges Shire Planning Scheme.
