Hidden from view and accessed through the Kingower State Forest, this 6-acre bush block is the perfect spot to escape to the country and have fun. This is one of 3 separate blocks for sale (see the individual listings), ranging in size from 6, 10 and 15 acres, all next to each other. The land is relatively level and cleared, with some mature gums and the Paper Gully seasonal creek passing through it, with Crown land on the northern boundary. The land is in the Farming Zone, so not suitable for building a residence, but ideal for casual weekend use. Rheola started as a gold mining town in the 1860s but is now a quiet backwater, 10 minutes to Inglewood for the basics, 45 minutes from Bendigo, and 2.5 hours to Melbourne. Access is via Pipeclay Road which is an unmade track through the bush.
