A ramp and a circular granite driveway welcomes visitors to a well-maintained country homestead and established gardens. A circular garden within the driveway features kurrajong trees, natives, crepe myrtles and over 100 agapanthus in summer - very pretty. There are 4 bedrooms and an office with a closed in verandah at the back leading to a laundry, toilet and small bedroom across the walkway at the other end. The main and second bedrooms offer built-in robes. The bathroom has a working spa and shower, as well as a good storage area. The kitchen contains a free standing electric stove/oven and plenty of storage. Of special interest is a home made Red River Gum serving bar opening up into the dining room. The lounge area features a wood fireplace, backed by a wall and hearth of Chinese tiles. It opens onto a front patio. A new evaporative cooling system works effectively in summer. A large paved, covered, outdoor entertainment area has an attached table and 6 chairs with plenty of space for busy children. The paddock close to the house has 4 stables with a saddle room, small horse yard and a loading ramp. A meat house, greenhouse and large workshop shed are in the next paddock. For vehicles the carport allows internal access to the house and the shed could accommodate up to 4 vehicles. A chicken coop and dog kennels could be constructed within the area near the stables. There is a rain water tank, septic tank and an electric pump on the river which allows for water for domestic and stock purposes to be pumped to the home, with a plumbed in water trough in the stable paddock. Mail delivery 3 times a week. May opportunities exist for enjoyable leisure activities such as - fishing, swimming, horse riding, short bushwalks, vegetable growing, photography and birdwatching.
