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A LOW MAINTENANCE LIFESTYLE IN A PREMIUM LOCATION

Positioned on the high side of the street with an easterly aspect to the front and located in a premium suburb with only a short driving distance to the Woden Town Centre, Curtin Primary school and the local shops, this much-loved duplex is ready to make it your own.

From the front porch, step into the light-filled lounge and dining room which opens out through a glass sliding door onto the paved entertaining area overlooking the well-established and low maintenance gardens. An electrically operated retractable awning provides shade over this area for entertaining family and friends during the warm summer months.

The updated kitchen with adjacent meals area has a large corner pantry, Miele induction cook top, electric oven with separate grill, dishwasher, and microwave hutch.

The main and third bedrooms have a built-in robe, and the renovated bathroom has a shower, toilet, tastic heater, vanity, heated towel rail and in-slab heating.

There is an additional toilet adjacent to the updated laundry room. The washing line is discreetly hidden by a bamboo screen behind the garage.

Car accommodation is provided by a single carport with a remote-controlled door and there is off street parking for one vehicle or a trailer alongside the driveway. To the rear of the carport, there is a garage which can be used as a storeroom, workshop, or a quiet space for the hobby enthusiast.

For those buyers who want to locate to a central Woden Valley premium suburb and do not want apartment living or for downsizers searching for a location close to the local amenities with minimal maintenance gardens, this home could be the one.

The suburb of Curtin is next to the suburbs of Yarralumla, Deakin, Hughes, Lyons and Weston. It is bounded by the Cotter Road, Tuggeranong Parkway, Yarra Glen and a green strip between it and Lyons to the south. Curtin is named after John Curtin, Australian Prime Minister between 1941 and 1945. Its streets are named after state premiers.
