Detailed leadlight windows, arched hallways, soaring ceilings and polished timber floors throughout compliment a versatile floorplan, comprising a light filled formal living room with bay windows and connected formal dining room, both featuring original open fireplaces. At the rear of the home, the large full width open plan living and dining domain overlooks the expansive north-west facing garden ensuring fantastic natural light and leafy vistas.

Adjoining the spacious family sized living area is the kitchen with stone benches providing ample storage throughout and integrated stainless-steel appliances underscored by tessellated tiles. Superior family accommodation comprising five generous bedrooms with built in robes over two levels serviced by two central family bathrooms, one with large spa bath. The main bedroom featuring walk in robe and ensuite.

Additional features include a separate laundry room, garden shed / workshop with powder room, split system heating/cooling, gas ducted heating and off-street parking accessed via Johnson Lane.
